• **To Hotel from Airport:** Take any train from the airport to the Helsinki station. The hotel is a short walk from the main train station. This requires an **ABC metro ticket**.

 From the Hotel to Aalto: The conference itself takes place at Ekonominaukio 1, Espoo. From the hotel, take the metro from the Kamppi metro station in the direction of Tapiola/Kivenlahti. Get out at the Aalto University metro station, and exit using the Datavägen/Tietotie exit. This requires an AB metro ticket.

• To Restaurant: The restaurant is on Soumenlinna, which can be reached using a public ferry that leaves Kauppatori every 20 minutes. At the end of the first day we'll take people to Suomenlinna, but in case you'd like to join later, the 2, 4 and 5 trams all go to Kauppatori, and it is a short walk from Kamppi/the hotel. Make sure you take the HSL ferry (near the Ferris wheel), and not e.g. the private ferry to Lonna/Soumenlinna which is quite a bit pricier. This requires and AB metro ticket.
