

The Research Master (rMSc) track provides a high value-added education for students whose ambition is to obtain challenging and demanding expert positions in the private or public sector, whether in applied or research-oriented jobs. For students planning to continue their studies towards a PhD, the rMSc track facilitates a smooth and fast transition from the Master's level to the PhD level. Moreover, it offers access to some of the best PhD programs in economics.

Are You Enthusiastic About Societal Challenges and Quantitative Methods?

The rMSc curriculum consists of core courses in microeconomics, macroeconomics, and econometrics, ensuring that students acquire state-of-the-art knowledge of methods and results in economics. Specialized courses in different subfields of economics further complement this foundation, integrating methodologi-

cal insight with real-world questions. rMSc students also have the opportunity to take more advanced-level field courses, enhancing their expertise and preparation for future research or professional roles.

Economics Master's programs at the GSE member universities are the foundational units awarding the degrees, setting the degree requirements, and organizing the courses. While each master's program offers a slightly different Research Master's Track in terms of degree requirements, the rMSc courses are organized within the Helsinki GSE teaching cooperation. Students can choose one university but have the flexibility to study courses from three different universities, thereby enriching their academic experience and broadening their perspectives.
